Please Note: These general education requirements are the minimum requirements across all disciplines and must be included in all degree plans to meet graduation requirements. Individual majors may have additional requirements; refer to the UTPB college catalog for additional information.

Students planning to major in Biology, Computer Science, Earth Science, Geology, or Mathematics should refer to the catalog under their major field of study for proper selection of lab science courses.

Students seeking a Bachelor of Business Administration degree must complete ECON 2301 & 2302 in addition to the three hour social science requirement. Management and Marketing majors must take both SOCI 1301 and PSYC 2301. Accounting and Finance majors may take either SOCI 1301 or PSYC 2301.

MATH 1324 & 1325 should be taken by students seeking a Bachelor of Business Administration. Calculus I & II (Math 2313 & 2314 or 2413 & 2414) should be taken by students planning to major in Biology, Computer Science, Earth Science, Geology or Mathematics.
